The purpose of this course is to enable students to write paragraphs in English which are clear and easy for the reader to understand. Towards the end of the course students will learn to put paragraphs together to form an essay.				
授業の目標				
This course aims to enable students to: ① write paragraphs in English that present interesting ideas in a way that is clear and easy to understand. ② write outlines and organize paragraphs into an essay on a current topic. ③ write freely and fluently about things they are interested in, to communicate with their classmates.				
授業の方法				
In each class students will do freewriting in order to develop fluency in English. They will look at models of good writing, and write and revise paragraphs about things of interest that they will share with their classmates in discussion activities.

Students will be better able to: ① express their ideas in writing in a way that is easy to understand. ② use their writing to begin discussions in English. ③ express themselves more easily for the purpose of communication in English.
